Rapid-Fire Presentation (RF)

Authors whose abstracts have been accepted as **Rapid-Fire Presentation** are invited to present their work during a dedicated Rapid-Fire Session in the Conference Room at the **51st Annual Meeting of the European Paediatric Ophthalmological Society (EPOS 2026)**.

Presentation Format

- **Presentation duration:** 3 minutes
- **Discussion:** Questions and discussion will take place **at the end of the session**, after all Rapid-Fire presentations have been delivered.
- The presentation must be prepared in **English**.
- To ensure that your presentation fits within the allocated time, we recommend using a **maximum of 6 slides**, including the title and closing/acknowledgement slides.
- We recommend structuring your presentation as follows:
 - *Background / Objective*
 - *Methods*
 - *Main Results*
 - *Conclusions*

Presentation File

- Presentations must be prepared in **Microsoft PowerPoint (.pptx)** format.
- Use standard fonts (e.g. **Arial, Calibri, Times New Roman**) to avoid compatibility issues.
- Please use **the 16:9 widescreen** format.
- If your presentation contains videos or animations, please ensure they are embedded correctly.
- Please keep strictly within the allocated presentation time. Session Chairs will ensure that the scientific programme runs on schedule.

Presentation Submission

To facilitate the technical preparation of the sessions, we kindly ask you to **send your PowerPoint presentation** to the EPOS 2026 Secretariat at **eposmeeting2026@eventrium.ro** by **13 September 2026**, whenever possible.

If you are unable to submit your presentation in advance, you may upload it in the **Speaker Ready Room**, according to the instructions below.



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Speaker Ready Room

- Presentations must be uploaded in the **Speaker Ready Room** at least **2 hours before** the scheduled session.
- Authors presenting in the first morning session are kindly requested to upload their presentation **the day before**.
- The presenting author must be present in the assigned conference room **at least 15 minutes before the beginning of the session**.

Important

- Unlike traditional poster presentations, **NO PRINTED POSTER is required**.
- Rapid-Fire presentations will be delivered as part of the scientific sessions in the Conference Room.

General Recommendations

- The presenting author must be registered for the congress.
- Authors are responsible for the accuracy of the content presented.
- Please ensure that all necessary permissions have been obtained for any copyrighted material included in your presentation.
- By presenting at the congress, authors consent to photography, filming, and live streaming during scientific sessions. **The sessions will not be recorded or available for viewing after the congress.**
- To ensure that the session runs on schedule, speakers are kindly requested **not to exceed their allocated presentation time**.
